Child Safeguarding Policies & Procedures

Please read & review each section below.

- Parents/Guardians will pay the agreed upon fee (if necessary) before the program takes place. The Y reserves the right to cancel a program time at any point for any reason. No refunds or returns for any cancelled sessions.
- **Weather Policy:** In the event of any inclement weather, the program will be closed for that day. This can include, but is not limited to, heavy rains, strong wind, thunder & lightning storms or excessive temperatures. In the event the program is to be cancelled, an email will be sent out to all registered participants informing of the decision to cancel the program for that week before the program is set to begin (if possible). In the event the weather changes during the course of the program to an unsafe state, the program will be immediately cancelled for the remainder of the scheduled time for that day. Parents/Guardians will be informed and will be required to pick up participants at the YMCA North End location.
- All parents/guardians will check-in with staff at the Ecole Le Sommet upon arrival and check-out upon session completion.
- **Parent/Guardian Participation Policy:** The Y has a participation policy and children aged 11 and under must be supervised at all times (including bathroom breaks, etc). While their child(ren) are participating in this program, parents/guardians agree to remain at Ecole Le Sommet field if their child(ren) are 11 years old. For parents/guardians of any youth 12 or older, they are only required to sign in with staff at the beginning and sign out at the conclusion of the session. Any parent/guardian failing to do so may result in the forfeiture of their child(ren)'s placement in the program. For more information visit www.ymcamoncton.ca
